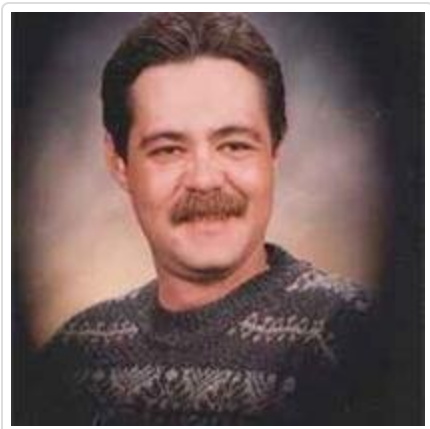




Blake Ingram

Blake Randall Ingram age 39 passed away Saturday, February 4, 2012 at Saint Francis Hospital in Tulsa, Oklahoma. Blake was born October 7, 1972 in Tucson, Arizona to Randy Ingram and Dava (Kirtley) Chrisco. In 1990 he graduated from Henryetta High School and attended Oklahoma State University and Tulsa Community College. He worked as a machine operator for an asphalt company.
