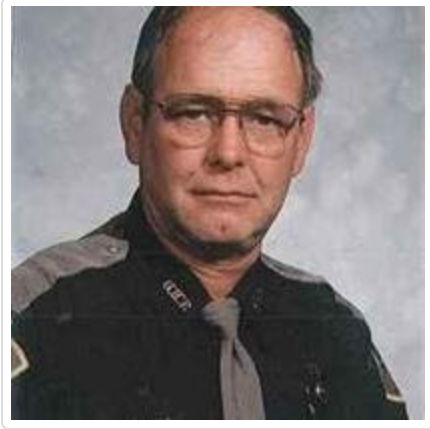




Bruce Lyons

Bruce Alan Lyons age 63 passed away on Friday, March 23, 2012 at Clarehouse in Tulsa, Oklahoma. Bruce was born August 1, 1948 in Bartlesville, Oklahoma to Richard Lyons and Juanita (Lewis) Lyons. He graduated from Bartlesville High School in 1966. He joined the United States Navy in July of 1966 and served until July 1969 when he was honorably discharged. He married Alice Hudson on April 18, 1975 . Bruce continued his education at NSU and received his Bachelors of Science degree in Criminal Justice in 1981. Bruce most recently worked as a Transportation Enforcement Officer for the Oklahoma corporation Commission for fourteen years after having worked as a Oklahoma Highway Patrolman for twenty-five years.
