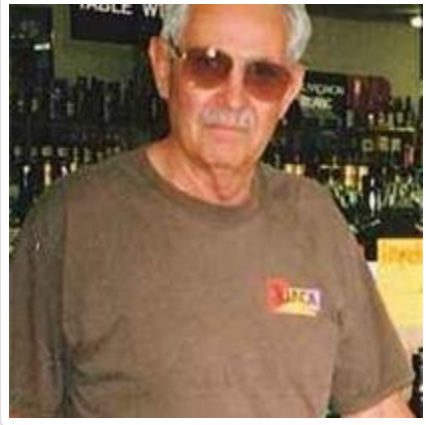




Charles Brucks
