



## Jack Covington

August 25, 1926 - April 30, 2008

Ted (Jack) Gilford Covington, Jr. age 81 passed away at the Claremore Veterans Center on Thursday, April 30, 2008. Jack was born August 25, 1926 to Ted G. Covington, Sr. and Alice C. (Saxon) in Tulsa, Oklahoma. He attended Lone Star Elementary in Sapulpa and Tulsa Central High School. He joined the United States Navy during World War II and was a signal man. Jack married his wife, Betty on October 7, 1983 in Glenpool, Oklahoma. Jack worked as a moulder by trade; for T & L Foundry and for twenty plus years he worked for Flanagan Iron works before he retired.
