Leonard James "Bill" Handley age 93 passed away Wednesday, March 21, 2007 at University Village, Tulsa, Oklahoma. Mr. Handley was born October 19, 1913 to Christian M. Handley and Pearl (Humphrey) Handley in Norfolk, Nebraska. In 1931 he graduated from Deul County High School.
